- On days when students have an exam in the morning they must attend registration at 8.30am in their usual form rooms. They will then be sent to the netball court to line up for the first exam of the day.

- Students must remain in school until the end of their last exam of the day. Where they have an exam in the first and third sessions, they will be allowed to complete revision, under staff supervision, in the second session.
- The majority of students will take their exams in the Sports Hall. Those who have exam concessions may be required to go to room W7 or the Library to complete their exams. The SEN department will be able to confirm these details.
- When the Sports hall is being used for public exams, Yr10 exams will be re-roomed elsewhere.
- Exams will be conducted under the normal 'public exams' regulations, details of which are available on the school website, in the Parents/Exams section.
- Normal lessons resume for all students on Thursday 26 June.
