## Course: Edexcel Fine Art A-Level

A-Level Art is an accumulative qualification made up of a combination of **artwork** completely coursework based units. You will use a variety of different mediums, such as painting, drawing, photography, digital mediums and printmaking. Realistic painting and drawing are an integral part of the course.

## ASSESSMENT OBJECTIVES

Course work is assessed in relation to four Assessment Objectives:

**AO1: Development of Ideas**

**AO2: Experimentation and Refinement**

**AO3: Observational Recording/Technique**

**AO4: Final Piece**

## TASKS

Your transition tasks have been set to help you develop your skills in each of Assessment Objective 1, 2 and 3 before you start A-Level Art. These tasks will give the opportunity to explore and practise these skills without the restrictions of a coursework unit assessment.

### Task 1 (AO1)

Go to see an exhibition at any of the fantastic free exhibition **galleries** in London that you think you will find interesting and select an artist that you want to explore further.

- Do further research on this artist and **create an** analysis page for this chosen artist.

- Create a study of one of this artist's works using appropriate media.
- Take primary sources that respond to this artist and create response work from your primary sources in appropriate media.

### Task 2 (AO2)

Create experimental artwork using media that you have not practiced with before. Try something new, experiment and see what exciting things you can create.

### Task 3 (AO3)

Take a series of photographs of a subject matter that you find interesting. Play with composition, colour and lighting in your photography.

Create a set of observational studies from both?? this subject matter from observation (with the objects in front of you) using whatever medium(s) you wish.

Visit as many of the excellent galleries in London as you can to see Artwork in the flesh! Many of them are free.
